This event, presented by Children's Security Blanket Project, Inc., a 501C3 organization, has been planned to assist a Spartanburg family - Jeff and Vicki Cook who are facing overwhelming medical bills as they continue to care for Sydney, their 12 year old daughter who had a brain tumor removed in May 2007. She remained in the hospital for ninety one days. Sydney receives therapy 3 days a week, is home bound from school, & requires a registered nurse for 12 hours a day. She continues to make remarkable progress and is confident that she will someday be "normal" again.



Attendance: 1000 people - our goal is to sell 1000 tickets to this worthwhile event.



QUEEN ALEXANDRA'S BIRDWING **\$5,000**

Like the Queen Alexandra's Birdwing, the rarest and largest of butterflies in the world today, a sponsorship commitment at this level is rare - if not almost impossible to find. Their status as Southern butterflies means they can be seen from spring through fall throughout much of the year in their range. For Sydney's Sake needs Swallowtails. CABBAGE WHITE **\$500**
